Community Build Project

- St Margaret's Academy, Livingston
St Margaret's Academy came to Malawi and worked with a youth group on the shores of Lake Malawi. They worked hand in hand with community members to construct a library and a classroom at the village school. The school returns to Malawi every other year to work on a different community project and arranges fundraising events throughout the school year.

School Linking Project

- Kingussie High School, Kingussie
Kingussie HS have linked with Muloza Community Day School in the Mulanje District of Malawi. With a standard group of around 20 pupils and 3 staff Kingussie spend 2/3 weeks in Malawi with their linked school on education projects, sports and workshops. They travel to Malawi every other year and always tag on a safari and time spent on the shores of Lake Malawi.

Classrooms for Malawi Charity Project

- Williamwood High School
Williamwood HS have been working in Northern Malawi in partnership with Scottish Charity 'Classrooms for Malawi'. Students spend 2 weeks renovating classrooms and interacting with students, joining lessons, after school clubs and taking part in community activities. A group of 16-18 yr olds travel every year to Malawi and the school is now partnered with their Malawian host school.
