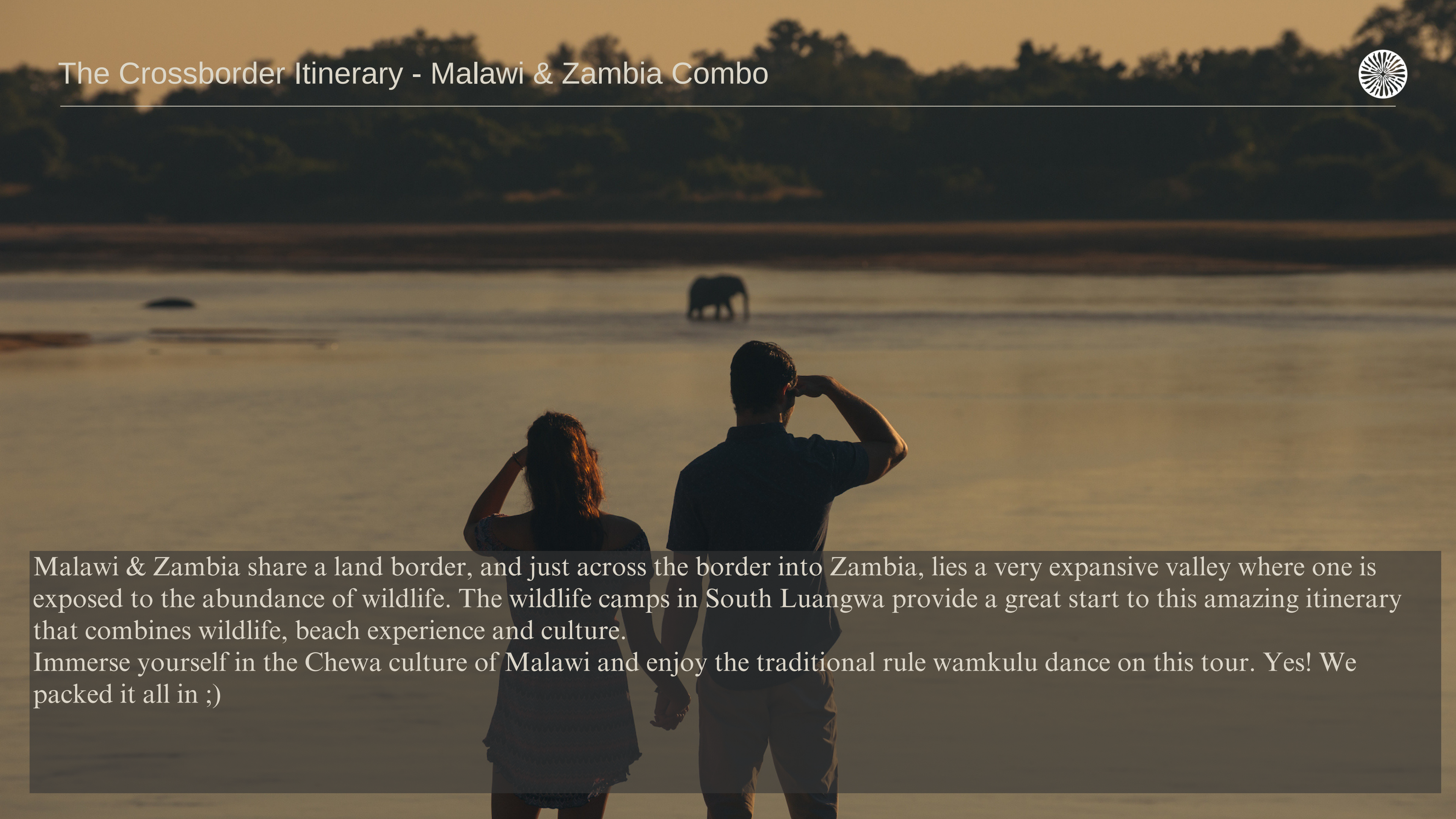

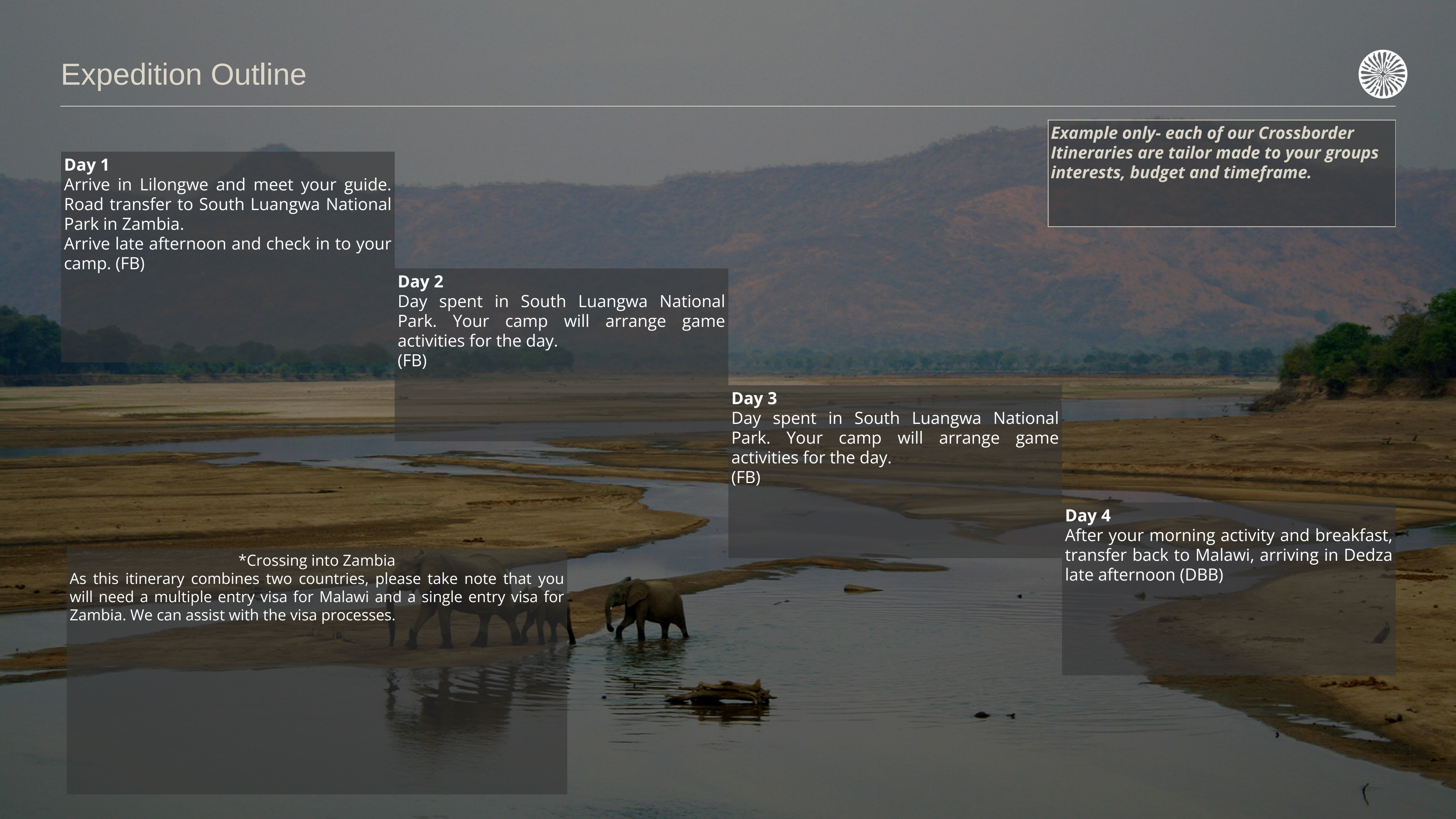

Day 6

Drive to Mua Mission to experience our cultural dances in one of the best performances you will see. Afternoon, proceed to Cape Maclear, get on a boat and transfer to Mumbo Island. (FB)

Day 7

Day spent on Mumbo Island - a pristine island located 10k. Off shore. All non-motorised activities are included. (FB)

Day 8

Transfer to Liwonde National Park, arriving in time for lunch. 4 x 4 game drive in the evening. (FB)
